PARKS Bingo Cariboo-Chilcotin Region

How to play: Become a citizen scientist by taking photos of plants, animals and other species every time you're in a B.C. provincial park or protected area and upload these observations to the BC Parks iNaturalist Project. Mark off the square when you make that observation. When you get five squares in a row, column or diagonally, you win! The biggest challenge of all: can you get every square?
